

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office  
Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Tribal Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-241**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office ("EPO")  
8 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Tribal Response Program Budget, in the amount  
9 of \$100,000.00 was approved by Resolution No. 23-211; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and  
11 approval of its FY 2024 EPO Bipartisan Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response  
12 Program Budget Amendment No. 1, incorporated by this reference, which will  
13 adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY  
15 2024 Department of Public Safety EPO Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Tribal  
16 Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
18 FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Bipartisan  
19 Infrastructure Law Tribal Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1.

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
22 expend the FY 2024 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office  
23 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law-Tribal Response Program Budget as amended,  
24 provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior  
25 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>**  
27 **day of AUGUST 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,005.7 FOR; -0-**  
28 **AGAINST; 257.6 [01] NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
29 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
30 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
31 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
32 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
