12		Appropriations Act of 2021 ("FY 21 Appropriations Act"); and
13	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has
14		identified the route numbers and sections in the National Tribal Transportation
15		Facility Inventory where road maintenance and repair operations will be
16		performed which is a requirement for receiving contract funds; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee reviewed the funding
18		proposal and recommend its approval.
19	NOW, THERI	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council desires to
20		enter a P.L. 93-638 contract with the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs to receive
21		approximately \$5,000,000.00 for the maintenance and repair of BIA Routes as
