8		Council representative leaves office during his or her term, any resulting vacancy
9		on a Legislative Council committee may be filled by seniority preference,
10		provided that a representative's transfer from another committee shall not
11		require a change in a committee's assigned meeting day. Thereafter, any
12		remaining vacancies shall be filled by the representative's successor in office.";
13		and
14	WHEREAS,	Representative Lucinda Allen resigned her office effective September 9, 2024 and
15		alternate Francis Homewytewa succeeded her as a Legislative Council
16		representative for the Sif Oidak District; and
17	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Order No. 24-279, the committee vacancies resulting from
18		Representative Lucinda Allen's resignation were filled by Representative Francis
19		Homewytewa in accordance with the Legislative Rules; and
20	WHEREAS,	prior to the former representative's resignation, Representative Lucinda Allen
21		served as chairperson of the Human Resources Development and Water
22		Resources Committees and those offices became vacant upon her resignation;
23		and
24	WHEREAS,	legislative committees are empowered to caucus and elect committee officers
25		(Legislative Rules, Article XII, Section 3(J)); and
26	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development did caucus on September 12, 2024 and
27		elected Representative Janice Felix as its chairperson; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee did caucus on September 12, 2024 and elected
29		Representative Daniel L.A. Preston, III as its chairperson and Representative
30		DeLisa Ramon as its vice chairperson; and
31	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it amends
32		Legislative Order No. 23-318 to certify Representative Janice Felix as the
