

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2025 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting
Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 24-287

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Hewel Ni'ok has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2025**
8 **KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant**
9 **Unrestricted Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of**
10 **\$237,599.88 to be funded from the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement**
11 **by the grantor, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
13 **FY 2025 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community**
14 **Service Grant Unrestricted Budget and recommend its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **FY 2025 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community**
17 **Service Grant Unrestricted Budget effective October 1, 2024 in amount of**
18 **\$237,599.88, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending**
19 **reimbursement by the grantor, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
22 **expend the FY 2025 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting**
23 **Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget, provided that any amendments**
24 **or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH**
27 **day of SEPTEMBER 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
30 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
