## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approval of the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program Grant Agreement and the FY 2025 City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Budget)

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2		negotiate and conclude agreements on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3		with local governments on all matters within the authority of the Tohono
4		O'odham Council"; "exercise the inherent powers of the Tohono O'odham Nation
5		by providing resolutions to promote, protect and provide for public health,
6		peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
7		its members"; "manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono
8		O'odham Nation and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation
9		and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be
10		pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance;
11		and "adopt, approve and amend annual budgets and to authorize the
12		expenditure of funds in accordance with these budgets" (Constitution of the
13		Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section l(c)(2), (d)(2) and (3), and (f); and
14	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Department of Public Safety was awarded the City of Tucson
15		High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program grant, Award No.
16		G24SA0007A, Grant No. HT-24-2966, the funds of which will be used for the Native
17		American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprises Task Force (NATIVE TF);
18		and
19	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety desires to enter into the
20		City of Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement with the City of Tucson, for the
21		grant period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025 for the purpose of
22		reimbursable overtime accrued during the grant period; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety has prepared and
24		submitted for review and approval its FY 2025 City of Tucson HIDTA Budget, in the
25		amount of \$17,000.00 to be funded by the Tohono O'odham Nation's general fund
26		and reimbursed by the City of Tucson HIDTA Program grant, Award No.
27		G24SA0007A, Grant No. HT-24-2966; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the City
29		of Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement and the FY 2025 City of Tucson HIDTA
30		Budget and recommend their approval.
31	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council grants a limited wavier of sovereign immunity in favor of the City of Tucson in order for the provisions of the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA)

Program Grant Agreement to be enforced.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odbam Legislative Council that the Tobono O'odbam Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program Grant Agreement and administer and expend these funds for the period of January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2025, and the Accounting Department is authorized to post the nnexpended balances of the FY 2025 City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Budget, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odbam Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the  $08^{\mathrm{TH}}$  day of OCTOBER 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section I(c)(2), (d)(2) and (3), and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
