12		projects in its 2024 Tucson Area IHS One-Line Listing (for FY25 Funding)
13		Sanitation Deficiency System ("Tucson Area Indian Health Service SDS priority
14		list"), which is incorporated by this reference; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided the
16		recommendations to the Health and Human Services Committee regarding the
17		most critical needs; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and recommends
19		approval of the most critical and desirable priority.
