

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2025 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham  
Nation and Brooke H. Bedrick, Esq.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-389**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the power "to employ legal counsel for the protection and advancement of the**  
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation..." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article**  
4 **VI, Section 2(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the increasing needs of Tribal Members ("Members") for legal representation has**  
6 **caused a need for contracted attorneys to represent Members in cases where the**  
7 **Tohono O'odham Advocate Program is ethically conflicted out of the**  
8 **representation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Advocate Program has prepared and submitted for review**  
10 **and approval FY 2025 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono**  
11 **O'odham Nation ("Nation") and Brooke H. Bedrick, Esq., which is incorporated**  
12 **herein by this reference, to represent Tribal Members in certain Civil Conflict**  
13 **Cases who cannot be represented by the Nation's Advocate Program due to a**  
14 **conflict of interest; and**

15 **WHEREAS, fees for services provided under this Contract will be paid out of the FY 2025**  
16 **Advocate Program Budget in accordance with the terms of the FY 2025**  
17 **Professional Services Contract with Brooke H. Bedrick, Esq., which shall extend**  
18 **from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends**  
20 **approval by the Legislative Council.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
22 **FY 2025 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**  
23 **Brooke H. Bedrick, Esq., in substantially the form attached.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs**  
25 **the Nation's chairperson to execute the Professional Services Contract, provided**  
26 **that any amendments to the Professional Services Contract shall be submitted for**  
27 **prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup>**  
29 **day of NOVEMBER 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**  
30 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
31 **Article VI, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
