

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Setting November 21, 2024 Special Session for the FY 2023 Audit Presentation**  
**and American Rescue Plan Act Matters)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 24-395**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “establish rules and**  
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O’odham Council, standing**  
3 **committees, boards and special committees.” (Constitution of the Tohono**  
4 **O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council vests the Council**  
6 **with the authority to “by majority vote, call for a special session” (Legislative**  
7 **Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**


8 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative**  
9 **Council, provides that “[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at the**  
10 **Tohono O’odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O’odham**  
11 **Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the legislative**  
12 **representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the**  
13 **chambers located at Sells.”; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has requested a special session on November**  
15 **21, 2024 for the FY 2023 Audit presentation and American Rescue Plan Act**  
16 **matters.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it sets a**  
18 **special session on November 21, 2024 at a location to be designated by Legislative**  
19 **Council chairperson for the FY 2023 Audit presentation and American Rescue**  
20 **Plan Act matters.**

21 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
22 **NOVEMBER, 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0-**  
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
24 **Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by the**  
25 **Tohono O’odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
26 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
27 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


