

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting December 16, 2024 Special Session for Human Resources Department Update)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 24-408

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O’odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees.” (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council vests the Council
6 with the authority to “by majority vote, call for a special session” (Legislative
7 Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and


8 **WHEREAS,** Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative
9 Council, provides that “[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at the
10 Tohono O’odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O’odham
11 Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the legislative
12 representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the
13 chambers located at Sells.”; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development Committee has requested a special session
15 on December 16, 2024 for Human Resources Department update.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it sets a
17 special session on December 16, 2024 Desert Diamond Casino - Tucson for Human
18 Resources Department update; provided that no other items will be added.

19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 09TH day of
20 DECEMBER, 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,151.05 FOR;
21 1,112.25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
22 Council by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by
23 the Tohono O’odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
25 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
