7	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 24-252, the Tohono O'odham Nation approved an agreement						
8		with the Queen Creek Irrigation District providing for delivery of a portion of the						
9		Nation's CAP water for water storage at a groundwater savings facility (the						
10		"Storage Agreement"); and						
11	WHEREAS,	the Storage Agreement allows the parties to negotiate a quantity of water and a						
12		price each year, as set forth in an Annual Scheduling Agreement; and						
13	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Department recommends a quantity of water and a price as						
14		set forth in the 2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement attached to this resolution,						
15		subject to adjustment in accordance with the Storage Agreement.						
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the							
17		2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement with the Queen Creek Irrigation District						
1 8		substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the						
19		Nation to execute it; provided, that the 2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement shall						
20		be subject to adjustment in accordance with the Storage Agreement.
