**RESOLUTION NO. 24-416** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State, and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,
5		or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
6		Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 23-089, the Tohono O'odham Nation approved an agreement
8	,	with the New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District providing for delivery of a
9		portion of the Nation's CAP water for water storage at a groundwater savings
10		facility (the "Storage Agreement"); and
11	WHEREAS,	the Storage Agreement allows the parties to negotiate a quantity of water and a
12	,	price each year, as set forth in an Annual Scheduling Agreement; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Department recommends a quantity of water and a price as
14	,	set forth in the 2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement attached to this resolution,
15		subject to adjustment in accordance with the Storage Agreement.
16	NOW. THERI	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
17	ŕ	2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement with the New Magma Irrigation and Drainage
18		District substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman
19		of the Nation to execute it; provided, that the 2025 Annual Scheduling Agreement
20		shall be subject to adjustment in accordance with the Storage Agreement.
