

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2025 Contract between the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch  
and Tyler Technologies, Inc.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-012**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**  
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with ... private persons or organizations on**  
4 **all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution of**  
5 **the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
7 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to appropriate**  
8 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
9 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
10 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
11 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's (Nation) Judicial Branch desires to purchase a**  
13 **probation supervision case management software system from Tyler**  
14 **Technologies, Inc., for the Judicial Branch; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch submitted an agreement for the purchase and installation of**  
16 **the software; and**

17 **WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies, Inc., proposes to charge implementation costs of \$146,920.00,**  
18 **based on an agreement payment schedule that includes 3 years of software**  
19 **updates and annual fees for an additional \$110,315.00, for a total cost of**  
20 **\$257,235.00; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch proposes to pay this amount from the Judicial Branch's**  
22 **American Rescue Plan Act Budget, passed by Resolution No. 22-070 ("ARPA**  
23 **funds"); and**

24 **WHEREAS, this Agreement exceeds the amount the Chief Judge is authorized to negotiate,**  
25 **execute, and otherwise conclude under 26 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Article 4, Section**  
26 **1404(B) of the Nation's code, and therefore, Legislative Council approval is**  
27 **required; and**


28 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has reviewed the Agreement and recommends approval.**

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
30 **FY 2025 Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch and Tyler**  
31 **Technologies, Inc., in the amount of \$257,235.00 which shall be funded by the**  
32 **Judicial Branch ARPA funds.**


1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chief Judge, or in  
2 his absence the Deputy Chief Judge, is authorized to execute the Contract in  
3 substantially the form attached, provided that any amendments will be  
4 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup>  
6 day of JANUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;  
7 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
8 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
9 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).




