2		amount of \$19,000,000.00 was approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 22-							
3		311 and subsequently amended by Resolution No. 24-362; and							
4	WHEREAS,	the American Rescue Plan Act requires funds to be obligated by December 31,							
15		2024 and gives an additional two years for completion of projects and/or delivery							
6		of services by December 31, 2026; and							
17	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY							
8		2025-2027 Legislative Replacement Building Supplemental Budget in the amount							
19		of \$21,979,004.47, which is incorporated by this reference; and							
20	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2025-2027 Legislative							
21		Branch Legislative Replacement Building Supplemental Budget and							
22		recommends its approval.
