

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Design-Build Amendment for the Legislative Branch Replacement Building)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-019

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to “negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the**
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation... with private persons or organizations on all matters**
4 **within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council” (Constitution, Article VI,**
5 **Section 1(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Council has prescribed the duties and powers of the Council Chairperson and**
7 **Vice Chairperson (collectively, “legislative officers”) by adopting the Legislative**
8 **Rules and by passing Legislative Order No. 06-047, “Amended Delegation of**
9 **Authority to Legislative Council Chairperson and Vice Chairperson”;** and

10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council by Resolution No. 22-311 approved the FY 2022-FY 2025**
11 **Legislative Branch American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) Budget, which includes**
12 **funding to cover costs associated with the construction of the Legislative Branch**
13 **replacement building, and which was subsequently amended by Resolution No.**
14 **24-362 approving the FY 2025-FY 2027 Legislative Branch ARPA Budget; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council by Resolution No. 24-250 approved the Design Phase**
16 **Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Legislative Branch and Axios Builders**
17 **LLC (“Agreement”) for the design phase of the Legislative Branch replacement**
18 **building; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council chairperson has submitted for review and approval the**
20 **Design-Build Amendment between the Tohono O'odham Legislative Branch and**
21 **Axios Builders LLC, which is incorporated by this reference; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council officers have reviewed the Design-Build Amendment and**
23 **recommend its approval.**


24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
25 **Design-Build Amendment in substantially the form attached.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
27 **Legislative Council chairperson to execute the Design-Build Amendment.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
29 **day of JANUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,134.5 FOR;**
30 **128.8 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
31 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




