

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Service Agreement between National Credit Reporting and the Tohono
O'odham Nation and Granting a Limited Waiver of the Nation's Sovereign
Immunity and Indemnification in favor of National Credit Reporting)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-024

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Legislative Council with the**
2 **power "to consult, negotiate, and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf**
3 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State, and local governments and**
4 **other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or**
5 **with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the**
6 **Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1 (f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") has negotiated a Service Agreement with**
8 **National Credit Reporting ("NCR") for the provision of criminal background**
9 **checks needed for election purposes for the period from the date of the last**
10 **signature on the service agreement through September 30, 2025; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Service Agreement contains an indemnification provision that requires the**
12 **Nation grant a limited waiver of its sovereign immunity to NCR to indemnify NCR**
13 **under the circumstances stated in the Service Agreement; and**


14 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed the Service Agreement, including the limited**
15 **waiver of sovereign immunity, and recommends its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
17 **Service Agreement, including the limited waiver of sovereign immunity, between**
18 **the Nation and NCR, in substantially the form attached hereto.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the Service**
21 **Agreement.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH**
23 **day of JANUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,016.2 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 247.1 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
25 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
