9		checks needed for election purposes for the period from the date of the last						
10		signature on the service agreement through September 30, 2025; and						
11	WHEREAS,	the Service Agreement contains an indemnification provision that requires the						
12		Nation grant a limited waiver of its sovereign immunity to NCR to indemnify NCR						
13		under the circumstances stated in the Service Agreement; and						
14	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee has reviewed the Service Agreement, including the limited						
15		waiver of sovereign immunity, and recommends its approval.						
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the							
17		Service Agreement, including the limited waiver of sovereign immunity, between						
18		the Nation and NCR, in substantially the form attached hereto.
