

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Additions to the Master List for Eligible Minor Tohono O'odham Members
for the Fourth Per Capita Distribution and Authorizing the Transfer of Funds
to set up a Trust Account at Principal Trust Company)

RESOLUTION NO. 25-032

1 **WHEREAS,** on June 28, 1997, the Nation's voters approved Initiative No. IN-01-97, the
2 "O'odham Voice on Use of Gaming Revenues" (the "Initiative"), which authorizes
3 per capita payments to the Nation's members provided that sufficient gaming
4 revenues are available; and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Ordinance for the Regulation of Gaming Activities Within the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation (the "Gaming Ordinance") was subsequently amended to
7 authorize per capita distribution payments in accordance with the Initiative
8 (Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-303); and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council did adopt the Tohono O'odham Nation Revenue Allocation
10 Plan pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 09-164; and

11 **WHEREAS,** on June 15, 2009, the Tohono O'odham Nation received notice from the Secretary
12 of the Department of Interior that the Tohono O'odham Nation Revenue
13 Allocation Plan was approved; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Membership Services submitted to
15 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the Master List for Eligible Minor
16 Tohono O'odham Members for the Fourth Per Capita Distribution ("Master List")
17 for review and approval; and

18 **WHEREAS,** Legislative Council approved the Master List with the initial number of 8,665
19 verified minor members (Resolution Number 09-429); and

20 **WHEREAS,** the Enrollment Program has identified 2 eligible minor members who were left
21 off the Master List for the fourth per capita distribution; and

22 **WHEREAS,** the 2 minor members eligible for the fourth per capita payment did not have the
23 Principal Trust Company account established in accordance with the Principal
24 Trust Agreement, which was approved by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
25 Resolution No. 06-258; and

26 **WHEREAS,** the Nation's Treasurer has calculated the accrued interest due to the eligible
27 minor members for the fourth per capita payment.

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:

- 29 1. Approves the addition of 2 eligible Tohono O'odham minor members to the
30 Master List for Eligible Minor Tohono O'odham Members for the Fourth Per

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
Capita Distribution, who are listed in the attached February 2025 Additions to the Minor Master List for the Fourth Per Capita Distribution.

2. Authorizes the Office of the Treasurer to transfer \$4000 (2 x \$2000 = \$4000) from the Principal Trust Company Fourth Per Capita Excess Funds Account to establish a trust account for the minors at Principal Trust Company pursuant to the terms of the Trust Agreement approved by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 06-258.
3. Authorizes the Office of the Treasurer to transfer \$3,917.68 from the Principal Trust Company Fourth Per Capita Excess Funds Account to pay the accrued interest income due for the fourth per capita payment.
4. Authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation or a designated official to execute such other documents as may be necessary to implement this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that any future additions to the Master List for Minor Eligible Members for the Fourth Per Capita Distribution are subject to the approval of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of FEBRUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).






