

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2025 Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-037

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2025 Judicial Branch Tribal Budget was approved by Resolution No. 24- 282**
8 **in the amount of \$9,105,710.39; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**
10 **2025 Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by**
11 **this reference and which will adjust personnel, operational, and/or capital line**
12 **items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2025 Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1 will decrease the**
14 **budget amount of \$9,105,710.39 to \$9,043,897.18; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2025**
16 **Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.**


17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2025 Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2024,**
19 **which will decrease the budget amount of \$9,105,710.39 to \$9,043,897.18.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chief Judge and**
21 **any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2025**
22 **Judicial Branch Tribal Budget Amendment No. 1 as amended, provided that any**
23 **modifications or amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**


25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH**
26 **day of FEBRUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**

28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




