

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2025-2027 Sells District North Communities Supplemental Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-047

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Nation,**

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a**
6 **treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished**
7 **a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and**
8 **all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or**
9 **other authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district**
10 **council.**

12 **WHEREAS, by Sells District Council Resolution No. SD-21-25, the Sells District has authorized**
13 **the FY 2025-2027 Sells District North Communities Supplemental Budget, which**
14 **is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$352,929.83; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2025-2027 Sells District**
16 **North Communities Supplemental Budget and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2025-2027 Sells District North Communities Supplemental Budget effective**
19 **October 1, 2024 in the amount of \$352,929.83, which shall be funded by FY 2024**
20 **Sells District North Communities carryover funds.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2025-2027 Sells**
22 **District North Communities Supplemental Budget shall be managed and**
23 **expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or**
25 **modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and**
26 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH**
28 **day of FEBRUARY 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
29 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
