12	WHEREAS,	by San Xavier District Council Resolution No. SXDC 02-25-10, the San Xavier
13		District has authorized and submitted for review and approval its FY 2025 San
14		Xavier Cooperative Association 9B Farm Cashout Fund Budget Amendment,
15		which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or
16		personnel line items; and
17	WHEREAS,	the FY 2025 San Xavier Cooperative Association 9B Farm Cashout Fund Budget
