

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2025 Chukut Kuk District Tecolote Community Mining Royalties Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 25-101

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** by Chukut Kuk District Council Resolution No. 2025-01, the Chukut Kuk District
13 has authorized the FY 2025 Chukut Kuk District Tecolote Community Mining
14 Royalties Budget in the amount of \$19,948.02, which is incorporated by this
15 reference; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2025 Chukut Kuk District
17 Tecolote Community Mining Royalties Budget and recommends its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 FY 2025 Chukut Kuk District Tecolote Community Mining Royalties Budget
20 effective October 1, 2024 in the amount of \$19,948.02, which shall be funded as
21 follows:

22 (1) FY 2020 Mining Royalties in the amount of \$10,593.16; and

23 (2) FY 2023 Mining Royalties in the amount of \$9,354.86.

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2025 Chukut
25 Kuk District Tecolote Community Mining Royalties Budget shall be managed and
26 expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the
27 Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or
28 modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and
29 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

32 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11th
33 day of APRIL 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,785.20 FOR; -0-






