The management of these funds shall be only by 6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has 7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono 8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks 9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or 10 vice chairman of the district council. 11 ; and 12 WHEREAS, the FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget in the 13 amount of \$548,404.54 was authorized by Baboquivari District Council 14 Resolution No. 2024-B-85 and approved by Legislative Conncil Resolution No. 24-15 325, and subsequently amended by Legislative Council Resolution No. 25-052; and 16 WHEREAS, by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2025-B-35, the Baboquivari 17 District has authorized and submitted for review and approval its FY 2025 18 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment No. 2, 19 which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or 20 personnel line items; and 21 WHEREAS. the FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget 22 Amendment No. 2 will not change the FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little 23 Tucson Community Budget amount of \$548,404.54; and 24 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2025 Baboquivari District 25 Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment No. 2 and recommends its 26 approval. 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the 28 FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget 29 Amendment No. 2 effective October 1, 2024, which will not change the FY 2025 30 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community Budget amount of 31 \$548,404.54.
