

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Extending Timeframe for Detailed Treasurer Drew Stevens to Serve)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-127**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Nation's chairperson**  
2 **with authority to appoint the Nation's treasurer, and other officers and heads of**  
3 **all governmental departments with the approval of the Tohono O'odham**  
4 **Legislative Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Appointed Officers law, 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, establishes the process for**  
6 **legislative review of appointed officer appointments by the appropriate oversight**  
7 **committee and the Legislative Council, and Section 4003(B) identifies the**  
8 **documents and information required to review, including the current job**  
9 **description and appointee's current resume, contact information, and written**  
10 **background investigation report; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Appointed Officers law provides that "no person shall perform the functions**  
12 **of, or be compensated for performing the duties of, an appointed officer for more**  
13 **than 180 consecutive or nonconsecutive days without approval of the**  
14 **appointment by resolution. The chairperson and Council may agree to extend the**  
15 **180-day period by resolution (1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4003(G)); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation's chairperson detailed Drew Stevens as the Nation's treasurer on**  
17 **November 15, 2024 and May 14, 2025 is the 180-day deadline to serve without**  
18 **Council approval; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Nation's chairperson is requesting a 180-day extension for the detailed**  
20 **treasurer to serve, which would expire November 10, 2025, and the Budget and**  
21 **Finance Committee recommends approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council extends the**  
23 **timeframe for Drew Stevens to serve as the Nation's detailed treasurer until**  
24 **November 10, 2025, provided that nothing in this resolution prevents the Nation's**  
25 **chairperson from presenting a Nation's treasurer appointee in accordance with**  
26 **the Appointed Officers law.**


27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>**  
28 **day of MAY, 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0-**  
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
30 **Article VII, Section 2(e) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
31 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
