3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)) and to "consult, negotiate and conclude
5		agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with
6		private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
7		Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
8	WHEREAS,	Agreements with other governments require approval by action of the Legislative
9		Council (26 T.O.C. Chapter One, Article 4, Contracting and Procurement
10		Authority, Section 1402(D)); and
11	WHEREAS,	the Judicial Branch has prepared and submitted a Memorandum of
12		Understanding (MOU), incorporated herein as Exhibit A, between the Judicial
13		Branch (Branch) and the United States District Court for the District of Arizona
14		(District Court) proposing that the Branch provide space for the District Court to
15		hold hearings for its Arizona Supervision to Aid Reentry (AZSTAR) Program; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Branch recognizes the importance of helping members of the Nation, and
17		others who may live on the Nation, to successfully complete participation in the
18		AZSTAR Program; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Branch proposes to allow the District Court to use a courtroom in the Justice
20		Center one business day per month to hold hearings for members of the Nation,
21		and others who may live on the Nation, who are participating in the AZSTAR
22		Program; and
23	WHEREAS,	the District Court will provide security oversight for the Magistrate Judge and
24		court participants appearing in an assigned courtroom of the Justice Center at no
25		cost to the Branch; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Judiciary Committee has reviewed the MOU and recommends its approval.
27	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
28		FY 2025 Memorandum of Understanding between the Tohono O'odham Judicial
29		Branch and the United States District Court for the District of Arizona.
