1   **WHEREAS,**     the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2                   within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3                   these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "all  
4                   expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5                   authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6                   Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and  
7   **WHEREAS,**     the FY 2021 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
8                   SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget was approved  
9                   by Resolution No. 20-433; and  
10   **WHEREAS,**    the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
11                   SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget in the amount  
12                   of \$1,931,458.08 was approved by Resolution No. 21- 335; and  
13   **WHEREAS,**    the FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
14                   SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget Amendment No.  
15                   1 was approved by Resolution No. 22-426; and  
16   **WHEREAS,**    the FY 2025 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
17                   SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget Amendment No.  
18                   2 in the amount of \$1,931,458.08 was approved by Resolution No. 25-103; and  
19   **WHEREAS,**    the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has  
20                   received a no cost extension notice from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to extend  
21                   the SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget authority  
22                   and period of performance through September 30, 2027; and  
23   **WHEREAS,**    the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has  
24                   prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2026 SXIR Consolidated  
25                   No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget Amendment No. 3, which is  
26                   incorporated by this reference and which will not change operational or capital  
27                   line items; and  
28   **WHEREAS,**    the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees  
29                   have reviewed the FY 2026 Planning and Economic Development Department  
30                   Roads Program SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget  
31                   Amendment No. 3 and the no cost extension and recommend approval.


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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the

cost extension of the Bureau of Indian Affairs award effective September 17, 2015,  
through September 30, 2027.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
expend the FY 2026 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads  
SXIR Consolidated No. 2 Wa:k Lane and Go:k Ka:wulk Wog Budget as amended,  
provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior  
approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24<sup>TH</sup>

Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).






