17	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 2025-B-56, the Baboquivari District Council has authorized and
18		submitted for review and approval its FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little
19		Tucson Community Budget Amendment No. 3, which is incorporated by this
20		reference and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and
21	WHEREAS,	the FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget
22		Amendment No. 3 will not change the FY 2025 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little
