9		the development and implementation of the National Community Health Aide
10		Program; and
11	WHEREAS,	CHAP TAG's membership is composed of 14 members: one primary and one
12		alternate for each of the 12 IHS Areas, one Tribal Self Governance Advisory
13		Committee representative, and one Direct Service Tribes Advisory Committee
14		representative; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating
16		Representative Lucius E. Lopez for appointment as the Tucson Area
17		representative on the CHAP TAG and Representative Ned Norris, Jr. as alternate.

19		Representative Lucius E. Lopez for appointment as the Tucson Area
20		representative on the Community Health Aide Program Tribal Advisory Group
