1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
2	WHEREAS,	Legislative Council with the power to "provide for, appoint, or provide for the
3		appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of committees, boards,
4		officers and agents" and "to preserve and cultivate native arts, crafts and
5		traditions" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(b) and Section 1(c)(8)); and
6	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically held a pageant to select young
7		O'odham women to represent and serve the Nation as official ambassadors and
8		in accordance with the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee Bylaws, the Miss
9		Tohono O'odham Nation Committee has coordinated the Miss Tohono O'odham
10		Nation pageant and acted as chaperones, among other duties and
1		responsibilities provided for by the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee
12	ĺ	Bylaws, as amended by Resolution No. 11-421, Resolution No. 16-089, and
13		Resolution No. 23-302; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee is comprised of "five enrolled
15		female members of the Nation who are at least 25 years of age with a preference
16		for O'odham speakers" who serve staggered, four year terms and who "shall
17		remain in office until their successors have been appointed and may serve an
18		unlimited number of terms" (Committee Bylaws, Sections 3102(B) and (D)); and
19	WHEREAS,	by Resolution Nos. 24-171 and 24-387, the Legislative Council appointed four
20		female Council alternates as interim Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee
21		members and their terms expired on June 17, 2025; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee currently has one appointed
23		member and four interim Committee members; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development Committee has advertised Miss Tohono
25		O'odham Nation Committee vacancies for a number of years, but only one eligible
26		applicant submitted her resume and letter of interest and was subsequently
27		appointed by the Legislative Council in 2024; and
28	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 25-219 and Resolution No. 25-220, the Tohono O'odham
29		Legislative Council appointed Council alternate Loretta A. Ortega,
30		Representative Janice Felix, Representative DeLisa Ramon, and Representative
31		Naomi Monte to serve as interim members on the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation
32		Committee; and

Legislative Council Alternate Christina C. Bell Andrews is interested and has agreed to serve as an interim Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee member: and WHEREAS. it is in the Nation's best interest to appoint Legislative Council Alternate Christina C. Bell Andrews as an interim Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee member to exercise the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee's functions while the Human Resources Development Committee continues to advertise and recruit applicants. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, notwithstanding Section 3102 (A) of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee Bylaws, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints Legislative Council Alternate Christina C. Bell Andrews to replace Representative DeLisa Ramon to serve as an interim member on the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee until a successor is appointed, provided that: (1)

- nothing in this resolution precludes the Legislative Council from appointing Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee members to replace the interim Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee member appointed by this resolution; and
- if an interim Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee member appointed (2) by this resolution no longer serves as a Legislative Council alternate for any reason, her appointment shall expire immediately.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH day of AUGUST, 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(b), Section 1(c)(8) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
