12	WHEREAS,	after July 25, 2024, these funds were made available for distribution from the BIA
13	ļ	to the Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Office of the Prosecutor has prepared and submitted for review and approval
15		its FY 2026 Office of the Prosecutor BIA One-Time Funding Budget, which is
16		incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$554,730.00 that shall be funded
17		by the BIA, as described above; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
19		2026 Office of the Prosecutor BIA One-Time Funding Budget and recommend its
20		approval.
