8		approval its FY 2026 Vocational Rehabilitation Program Budget, which is
9		incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$450,723.00 to be funded from
10		the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the United
11	l İ	States Department of Education; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
13		reviewed the FY 2026 Department of Education Vocational Rehabilitation
14		Program Budget and recommend its approval.
15	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
16	:	Fy 2026 Department of Education Vocational Rehabilitation Program Budget
17		effective October 1, 2025, in amount of \$450,723.00 which shall be funded by the
18		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the United
19		States Department of Education.

21		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
