9		incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$135,000.00 to be funded from
10		the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the United
11		States Environmental Protection Agency; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
13		2026 Water Resources Department EPA Budget and recommend its approval.
14	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odbam Legislative Council approves the
15		FY 2026 Water Resources Department EPA Budget effective October 1, 2025 in the
16		amount of \$135,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
17		pending reimbursement from grantor, the United States Environmental
18		Protection Agency.

20		Nation's chairperson or any designated official to seek reimbursement for
21		indirect cost expenses in the event an indirect cost rate is approved.

24		expend the FY 2026 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection
