12	WHEREAS,	the portion of the FY 2026 Rodeo and Fair Budget in the amount of \$415,250.01
13		which shall be funded from the Nation's general fund is addressed by a separate
14		resolution; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
16		have reviewed the FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Rodeo and Fair
17		Revenue Funding Budget and recommend its approval.
18	NOW, THERI	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19		FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Rodeo and Fair Revenue Funding
20		Budget effective October 1, 2025, in the amount of \$50,000.00 of which \$10,000.00
21		shall be funded from donations and contributions and \$40,000.00 shall be funded
