

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic
Preservation Office Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-321

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2026 Tribal Historic Preservation Office Budget, which is
9 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$138,763.46, to be funded by the
10 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the U.S.
11 Department of the Interior National Park Service; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the
13 FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office
14 Budget and recommend its approval.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
16 FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office
17 Budget effective October 1, 2025, in the amount of \$138,763.46, which shall be
18 funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor,
19 the U.S. Department of the Interior National Park Service.


20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
22 expend the FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic
23 Preservation Office Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications
24 shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH
26 day of SEPTEMBER 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR;
27 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
28 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
29 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
30 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
31 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


