7		budgets" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)
8		and (3)); and
9	WHEREAS,	the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
10		approval its FY 2026 Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") Commission Fees
11		Revenue Funding Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount
12		of \$296,355.02 to be funded from the TERO Commission fees revenue funding; and
13	WHEREAS,	the portion of the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety TERO Budget in the
14		amount of \$579,735.47 to be funded by the Nation's general fund is addressed by
15		separate resolution; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
17		reviewed the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees
18		Revenue Funding Budget and recommend its approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20		FY 2026 Department of Public Safety TERO Commission Fees Revenue Funding
21		Budget effective October 1, 2025 in the amount of \$296,355.02, which shall be
22		funded from the TERO Commission fees revenue funding.
