

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham
Judicial Branch and Gibson's Office Solutions)**

RESOLUTION NO. 25-355

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with . . . private persons or organizations**
4 **on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council"**
5 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
7 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to appropriate**
8 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
9 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
10 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
11 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Judicial Branch desires to contract with Gibson's**
13 **Office Solutions to purchase and install office furniture for the Judicial Branch**
14 **Probation Building; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch submitted the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) for**
16 **review and approval; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the PSA amount, including contingency funding, totals \$132,378.30 for the**
18 **purchase and installation of office furniture for the Judicial Branch Probation**
19 **Building; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch proposes to pay this amount from the Judicial Branch's**
21 **American Rescue Plan Act Budget, passed by Resolution No. 22-070 ("ARPA**
22 **funds"); and**

23 **WHEREAS, this PSA exceeds the amount the Chief Judge is authorized to negotiate, execute,**
24 **and conclude under 26 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1, Article 4, Section**
25 **1404(B) of the Nation's Code, and therefore, Legislative Council approval is**
26 **required; and**

27 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Judiciary Committee has reviewed the PSA and recommends its**
28 **approval.**

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
30 **FY 2026 PSA between the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch and Gibson's Office**
31 **Solutions, for a total sum of \$132,378.30 for the purchase and installation of office**

furniture for the Judicial Center Probation Building which will be paid for with ARPA funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing herein is to be interpreted as an express or implied waiver of the Judicial Branch's, the Tohono O'odham Nation's, or any associated Nation's employee, agent, executive, or other representative's immunity from suit in any forum or in any jurisdiction.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chief Judge, or his delegate, is authorized to approve and execute the FY 2026 PSA between the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch and Gibson's Office Solutions as described herein, provided that any amendments must be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of OCTOBER 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Sections 1(d)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).






