5	WHEREAS,	the increasing needs of Tribal Members ("Members") for legal representation has
6		caused a need for contracted attorneys to represent Members in cases where the
7		Tohono O'odham Advocate Program is ethically conflicted out of the
8		representation; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Advocate Program has prepared and submitted for review
10		and approval FY 2026 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono
11		O'odham Nation ("Nation") and Saul Huerta, Esq., which is incorporated herein by
12		this reference, to represent Tribal Members in certain Adult and Juvenile
13		Criminal Cases who cannot he represented by the Nation's Advocate Program due
14		to a conflict of interest; and
15	WHEREAS,	fees for services provided under this Contract will be paid out of the FY 2026
16		Advocate Program Budget in accordance with the terms of the FY 2026
17		Professional Services Contract with Saul Huerta, Esq., which shall extend from
18		October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends
20		approval by the Legislative Council.
21	NOW, THERE	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22		FY 2026 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
23		Saul Huerta, Esq., in substantially the form attached.
24	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs
25		the Nation's chairperson to execute the Professional Services Contract, provided
26		that any amendments to the Professional Services Contract shall be submitted for
27		prior approval hy the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
