9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Advocate Program has prepared and submitted for review
10		and approval FY 2026 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono
11		O'odham Nation ("Nation") and Benjamin Aguilera, Esq., which is incorporated
12		herein by this reference, to represent Tribal Members in certain Adult and
13		Juvenile Criminal Cases who cannot be represented by the Nation's Advocate
14		Program due to a conflict of interest; and
15	WHEREAS,	fees for services provided under this Contract will be paid out of the FY 2026
16		Advocate Program Budget in accordance with the terms of the FY 2026
17		Professional Services Contract with Benjamin Aguilera, Esq., which shall extend
18		from October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends
20		approval by the Legislative Council.
21	NOW, THERE	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22		FY 2026 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
23		Benjamin Aguilera, Esq., in substantially the form attached.

25		the Nation's chairperson to execute the Professional Services Contract, provided
26		that any amendments to the Professional Services Contract shall be submitted for
