1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Constitution vests the Legislative Council with the power "to
2		consult, negotiate, and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other
4		Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with
5		private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
6		Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Branch wants to enter into a Lease Agreement
8		with the United Way Capital Corporation ("Landlord"), which is incorporated by
9		this reference, for approximately 9,800 square feet of temporary office space
10		located at 340 N. Commerce Park Loop, Suite 100, Tucson, Arizona 85745 (the
11		"Lease Agreement"); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Lease Agreement shall be for an initial 16-month term beginning upon its
13		execution and approval by United Way Capital Corporation, with options for up to
14		three consecutive 6-month renewals; and
15	WHEREAS,	the rent, projected taxes, and operating costs payments for the initial term, and
16		one renewal of the Lease Agreement are identified in the attached cost
17		breakdown and exceed the \$100,000.00 limitation on the Legislative Council
18		chairperson's contract approval authority; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Lease Agreement will be funded by the FY 2025-2027 Legislative Branch
20		Legislative Replacement Building Supplemental Budget Amendment No. 1, which
21	:	was approved by Resolution No. 25-386; and
22	WHEREAS,	Section 7.1 of the Lease Agreement requires the Legislative Branch to "indemnify,
23		defend and hold harmless Landlord from and against any claim, liability,
24		expense, lawsuit, loss or other damage, including reasonable attorneys' fees,
25		arising from or relating to Tenant's use of the Premises or Tenant's activities
26		within the Property"; and
27	WHEREAS,	Section 19 of the Lease Agreement requires that in the event of a dispute
28		concerning the condemnation or eminent domain applicable to more than 20%
29		of the rentable floor area of the premises, or an attempted assignment or
30		sublease of the premises by the Legislative Branch, the controversy shall be
31		settled by arbitration; and

Saunders is vested by Legislative Order No. 06-047 with 1 WHEREAS. authority over Branch buildings and control and management of authorized 2 3 expenditures from the approved Legislative Branch budgets as amended and 4 recommends that the Legislative Council approve the Lease Agreement. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the 5 Lease Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Legislative Branch and United 6 7 Way Capital Corporation, for office space in Tucson as referenced in the attached document and authorizes the Legislative Council chairperson to execute the 8 9 Lease Agreement. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants a limited waiver 10 of the Legislative Branch's sovereign immunity solely in accordance with Section 11 12 19 of the Lease Agreement.
