6		Convention and Marketplace in Seattle, Washington from November 16, 2025 -
7		November 21, 2025; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has worked closely with the NCAI and with Native
9		American Tribes across the United States to address numerous national issues of
10		importance to Indian Country; and
11	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national
12		level involvement in these issues by participating in the NCAI 82nd Annua
13		Convention and Marketplace in Seattle, Washington from November 16, 2025 -
14		November 21, 2025.
15	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that i
16		authorizes Tohono O'odham Chairman Verlon Jose to serve as the Nation's voting
17		delegate and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Chairwoman Wavalene
18		Saunders to serve as the Nation's alternate voting delegate in Seattle, Washington
19		from November 16, 2025 - November 21, 2025 and at all other NCAI meetings and
20		sessions for the 2025-2026 term; provided that the voting delegate, alternate, and
21		any Legislative Council representatives attending the NCAI 82 <sup>nd</sup> Annua
22	Ĺ	Convention and Marketplace and other NCAI meetings and sessions are
23		authorized to present and advocate for resolutions and positions previously
24		approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
