

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Extending Time for Marietta Martin to Serve as Detailed Executive  
Director of Membership Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-413**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Nation's chairperson  
2 with authority to appoint the Nation's treasurer, and other officers and heads of  
3 all governmental departments with the approval of the Tohono O'odham  
4 Legislative Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and  
5 **WHEREAS,** the Appointed Officers law provides that "no person shall perform the functions  
6 of, or be compensated for performing the duties of, an appointed officer for more  
7 than 180 consecutive or nonconsecutive days without approval of the  
8 appointment by resolution. The chairperson and Council may agree to extend the  
9 180-day period by resolution." (1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4003(G)); and  
10 **WHEREAS,** the Nation's chairperson detailed Marietta Martin as the Executive Director of the  
11 Department of Membership Services on May 19, 2025, and the 180-day period to  
12 serve without Legislative Council approval expires on November 15, 2025; and  
13 **WHEREAS,** the Nation's chairperson has requested an extension of Marietta Martin's service  
14 as the Detailed Executive Director of the Department of Membership Services,  
15 and the Rules Committee recommends that the Legislative Council approve the  
16 extension.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council extends the  
18 time for Marietta Martin to serve as Detailed Executive Director of the  
19 Department of Membership Services for an additional 180-days.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>  
21 day of **NOVEMBER 2025** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR;  
22 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
23 Article VII, Section 2(e) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
24 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
26 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


