

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting January 7, 2026, Special Session for a "Water 101" Presentation)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 25-423

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and


5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council
6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative
7 Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources Committee has requested a special session on January 7,
9 2026 for a "Water 101" presentation and other related water issues.

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
11 special session on January 7, 2026 for a "Water 101" presentation and other
12 related water issues at a location to be designated by the Legislative Council
13 chairperson.


14 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of
15 DECEMBER, 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR;
16 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
18 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
20 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
