

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Representatives Francis Homewytewa and Naomi Monte as
Interim TERO Commissioners)**

RESOLUTION NO. 26-037

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the authority to enact ordinances "to
2 promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and
3 general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and the power
4 "to provide for, appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the
5 duties and powers of committees, boards, officers and agents" (Constitution of
6 the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(b)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** in 1985 the Papago Council enacted the Papago Employment Rights Ordinance
8 ("TERO Ordinance"), which established the Papago Employment Rights
9 Commission, since renamed as the Tribal Employment Rights Commission (the
10 "TERO Commission") and vesting the Council with the power to select, appoint,
11 and remove TERO Commissioners by resolution (13 Tohono O'odham Code
12 Chapter 1, Tribal Employment Rights); and

13 **WHEREAS,** in 2012, the Nation suspended the TERO Commissioners by Resolution No. 12-384
14 "Suspending TERO Commissioners" and ultimately removed the TERO
15 Commissioners by Resolution No. 14-060 "Removing TERO Commissioners"; and

16 **WHEREAS,** in 2013, when the TERO Commissioners were suspended, but had not yet been
17 removed, interim TERO Commissioners were appointed to serve until successors
18 could be appointed so that the Commission could conduct business, ensure that
19 Indian preference was enforced, and provide necessary services for the Nation's
20 members (Resolution Nos. 13-093, 13-094, 13-095, 13-096); and

21 **WHEREAS,** beginning in 2016, when the previous interim TERO Commissioners resigned, the
22 Legislative Council appointed members of the Human Resources Development
23 Committee as interim Commissioners so that the TERO Commission could
24 continue to conduct business (Resolution No. 16-063, Resolution No. 16-412,
25 Resolution No. 19-241, Resolution No. 22-239); and

26 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 23-124, the Legislative Council approved the appointment of
27 James Moreno to the TERO Commission replacing former Council Representative
28 Lucinda Allen; and

29 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 25-118, the Legislative Council approved the appointment of
30 Ned Norris, Jr. to the TERO Commission; and

1 **WHEREAS, on November 14, 2025, Representative Ned Norris, Jr. resigned as TERO**
2 **Commissioner; and**


3 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee recommends that**
4 **Representatives Francis Homewytewa and Naomi Monte be appointed to serve as**
5 **interim TERO Commissioners to assist TERO Commissioner James Moreno with**
6 **the duties and responsibilities of the TERO Commission.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints**
8 **Representative Francis Homewytewa and Representative Naomi Monte as**
9 **Interim TERO Commissioners to join Interim TERO Commissioners Janice Felix**
10 **and Delisa Ramon, and TERO Commissioner James Moreno, provided that:**

- 11 (1) **nothing in this resolution precludes the Legislative Council from**
12 **appointing TERO Commissioners to replace interim TERO**
13 **Commissioners;**
- 14 (2) **if an interim TERO Commissioner appointed by this resolution no longer**
15 **serves on the Human Resources Development Committee for any reason,**
16 **his or her appointment shall expire immediately;**
- 17 (3) **the interim TERO Commissioners appointed by this resolution shall not be**
18 **eligible for per diem, mileage, travel expenses or any other payments as**
19 **interim TERO Commissioners; and**
- 20 (4) **each interim Commissioner shall continue to serve until a successor has**
21 **been appointed.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH**
23 **day of FEBRUARY 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR;**
24 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(h) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
27 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
28 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
