

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson
Community Activity Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 26-042

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2026-B-03, the Baboquivari
13 District has authorized the FY 2026 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson
14 Community Activity Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the
15 amount of \$35,010.91; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2026 Baboquivari District
17 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Activity Budget and recommends its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 FY 2026 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Activity Budget
20 effective October 1, 2025 in the amount of \$35,010.91, which shall be funded by the
21 FY 2025 Baboquivari District mining allocation.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2026
23 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Activity Budget shall be
24 managed and expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the
25 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that
26 any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under District Council
27 resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
28 Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of FEBRUARY 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).

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
