

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the First Extension of Intergovernmental Agreement for Mutual  
Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe  
and the Tohono O'odham Nation, Executed August 25, 2020)**

**DEFEATED  
RESOLUTION NO. 26-071**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "[t]o consult,  
2 negotiate and conclude agreements . . . on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
3 with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their  
4 departments, agencies, or political subdivisions . . . on all matters within the  
5 authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" and "[t]o exercise the inherent powers  
6 of the Tohono O'odham Nation by providing . . . resolutions . . . to promote, protect  
7 and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of  
8 the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution of the Tohono  
9 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Sections 1(c)(2) and (f)); and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council previously approved the  
11 Intergovernmental Agreement for Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement  
12 Assistance Between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation by  
13 Resolution No. 20-220; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Agreement permitted the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham  
15 Nation the option to extend the term of the Agreement for two additional five (5)  
16 year periods or any portion thereof; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation wish to extend the term  
18 of the Agreement for the first additional five (5) year period, which such period  
19 commences at the time of the expiration of the Agreement on August 25, 2025 and  
20 terminates on August 25, 2030; and

21 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the First Extension of Mutual  
22 Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and  
23 the Tohono O'odham Nation, Executed August 25, 2020 and recommends its  
24 approval.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
26 First Extension of Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Between  
27 the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation, Executed August 25,  
28 2020.

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
30 Nation's Chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the First


