

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting March 13, 2026 Virtual Special Session for Consideration of the Nation's FY 2027
Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Request for Western Police
and Fire Substation Technology and Equipment)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 26-094

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O’odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees” (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council (“Legislative
6 Rules”) vest the Council with the authority to “by majority vote, call for a special
7 session” (Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules further provide that, “[t]he Legislative Chairperson may
9 direct that a Council session be conducted virtually with Council representatives
10 attending by phone or through a designated technological application. . .”
11 (Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1(H)); and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Appropriations Committee has requested a virtual special session on March
13 13, 2026 for consideration of the Nation's FY 2027 Community Project
14 Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Request for Western Police and Fire
15 Substation Technology and Equipment.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it sets a
17 virtual special session on March 13, 2026 for consideration of the Nation's FY 2027
18 Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Request for
19 Western Police and Fire Substation Technology and Equipment.

20 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day of
21 MARCH, 2025 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.8 FOR;
22 691.3 AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
23 by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by the
24 Tohono O’odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
26 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


