

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Home Projects 2-Year
Standalone Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 26-171

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2026-B-29, the Baboquivari
13 District has authorized the FY 2026 Baboquivari District Topawa Community
14 Home Projects 2 Year – Standalone Budget, which is incorporated by this
15 reference, in the amount of \$317,394.33; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2026 Baboquivari District
17 Topawa Community Home Projects 2 Year – Standalone Budget and recommends
18 its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 FY 2026 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Home Projects 2 Year –
21 Standalone Budget effective October 1, 2025 in the amount of \$317,394.33, which
22 shall be funded by:

- 23 1. FY 2019 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Budget carryover funds
24 in the amount of \$174,701.87; and
- 25 2. FY 2020 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Budget carryover funds
26 in the amount of \$142,692.46.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2026
28 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Home Projects 2 Year – Standalone
29 Budget shall be managed and expended in accordance with Article IX Section 7 of
30 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided
31 that any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under District

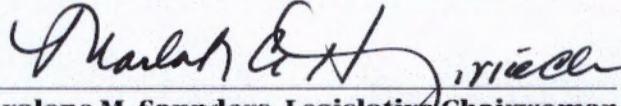

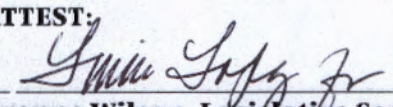
The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH

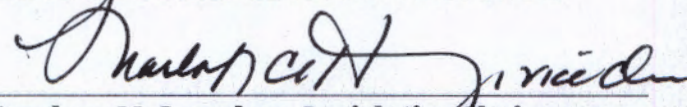

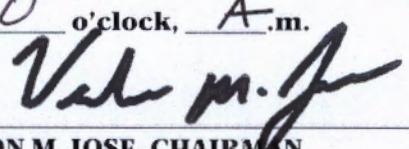

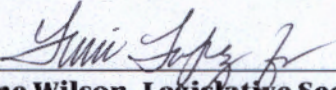
