

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic
Preservation Office Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 26-185

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office
8 Budget in the amount of \$138,763.46 was approved by Resolution No. 25-321; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office has
10 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2026 Budget Amendment
11 No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference, and which will adjust operational
12 and/or personnel line items; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office
14 Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the Department of Natural Resources FY
15 2026 Tribal Historic Preservation Office Budget by \$5,328.54 from \$138,763.46 to
16 \$144,092.00; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Cultural Preservation and Budget Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
18 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office Budget
19 Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office
22 Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2025, which includes a \$5,328.54,
23 increase from \$138,763.46 to \$144,092.00, that shall be funded by the Nation's
24 general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the U.S. Department of
25 the Interior National Park Service.

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
27 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
28 administer and expend the FY 2026 Department of Natural Resource Tribal
29 Historic Preservation Office Budget as amended, provided that any amendments
30 or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
31 Legislative Council.

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(Approving FY 2026 Department of Natural Resources Tribal Historic Preservation Office Budget Amendment No. 1)

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD day of JUNE 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
