

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency
Management Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 26-214

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management Budget**
8 **in the amount of \$1,148,194.34 was approved by Resolution No. 25-335; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
10 **approval its FY 2026 Office of Emergency Management Budget Amendment No. 1,**
11 **which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational line**
12 **items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management Budget**
14 **Amendment No. 1 will increase the Department of Safety FY 2026 Office of**
15 **Emergency Management Budget by \$78,381.60 from \$1,148,194.34 to**
16 **\$1,226,575.94; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget and Finance Committees have**
18 **reviewed the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency**
19 **Management Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management Budget**
22 **Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2025, which includes a \$78,381.60 increase**
23 **from \$1,148,194.34 to \$1,226,575.94 that shall be funded by the Nation's general**
24 **fund.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
26 **Nation chairperson or any designee official is authorized to administer and**
27 **expend the FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency**
28 **Management Budget as amended, provided that any amendment or**
29 **modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Legislative Council.**

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(Approving FY 2026 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management Budget Amendment No. 1)

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of JULY 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).

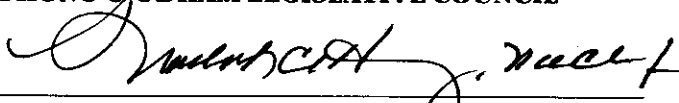

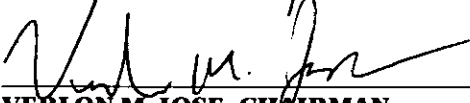
