

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham
Ha Ma:mscama I He We:mta Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 26-242

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham Ha Ma:mscama I He
8 We:mta Budget in the amount of \$645,508.41 was approved by Resolution No. 25-
9 335; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education has prepared and submitted for review and
11 approval its FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham Ha Ma:mscama
12 I He We:mta Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference
13 and which will adjust and create operational line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham Ha Ma:mscama I He
15 We:mta Budget Amendment 1 will not change the original budget amount of
16 \$645,508.41; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
18 reviewed the FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham Ha Ma:mscama
19 I He We:mta Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham Ha Ma:mscama I He We:mta
22 Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2025, which adjusts and creates
23 operational line items, but does not change the original budget amount of
24 \$645,508.41, that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
26 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
27 administer and expend the FY 2026 Department of Education Tohono O'odham
28 Ha Ma:mscama I He We:mta Budget as amended, provided that any
29 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
30 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day of AUGUST 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

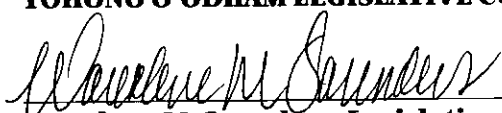

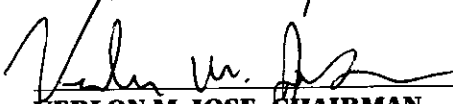
