

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting September 8-11, 2026 Special Session to Address FY 2027 Budgets)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 26-260

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the
6 Council with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session"
7 (Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section
8 1.D.1.); and

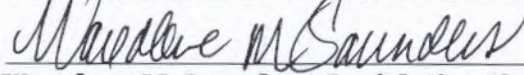
9 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
10 Council, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at the
11 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono
12 O'odham Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the
13 legislative representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other
14 than the chambers located at Sells."; and

15 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has requested a special session on
16 September 8-11, 2026 to address FY 2027 budgets.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
18 special session on September 8-11, 2026 to address FY 2027 budgets at a location
19 to be determined by the Legislative Council chairperson.

20 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of
21 AUGUST, 2026 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,321.1 FOR;
22 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
24 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
26 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).

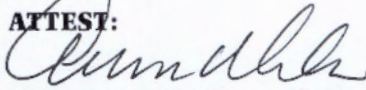
